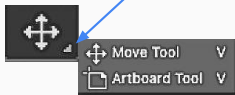


Main Menu

Toolbar

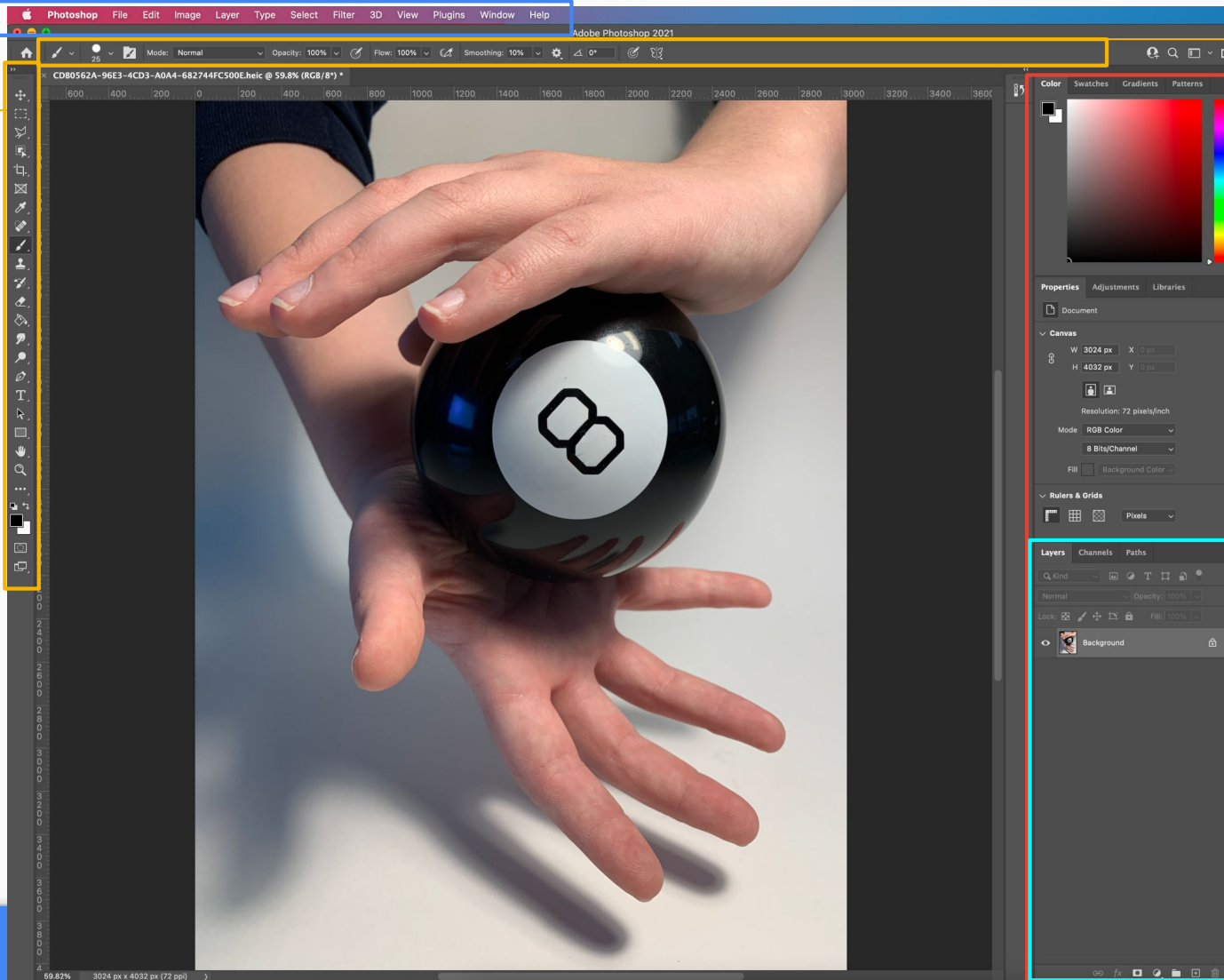
When you start Photoshop, the Tools panel appears here. Some tools in the Tools panel have options that appear in the context-sensitive options bar.

You can expand some tools to show hidden tools beneath them. A small triangle at the lower right of the tool icon signals the presence of hidden tools. Click and hold the triangle to see more options



You can view information about any tool by positioning the pointer over it. A small video clip will appear showing you the main function.

Options Bar

Each tool you select has context-specific options to it, which are found here.

The options bar changes whenever you select a different tool.

Panels

These items are found in the window tab of the main menu.

The Layers panel lists all layers, layer groups, and layer effects in an image.

You can use the Layers panel to show and hide layers, create new layers, and work with groups of layers.

You can access additional commands and options in the Layers panel menu.
